CNY Auto Auction Arbitration Changes:

Vehicles model year 2019 and older, and vehicles with over 115,000 miles, will have arbitration/post-sale available on the powertrain and drivetrain only.

- Vehicles 2014 and older will have arbitration/post-sale available on powertrain only (Engine and Transmission) - No arbitration for ANYTHING else, including frame.
- Vehicles over 175,000 miles are AS-IS including frame (absolutely no arbitration)
- Vehicles sold for \$3,000 and under are AS-IS including frame regardless of what is announced and what lights are displayed.
- If a check engine light is noted on a condition report or announced on the block the buyer must assume the repair is over \$800 to remedy the check engine light.
- The following are excluded from arbitration and PSI-All hybrid/electric vehicles (We do not have tools to diagnose these vehicles and the shops are currently
 - scheduling too far out for arbitration to be fair.)
- Components excluded from arbitration:
 - -Power running-boards
 - -Power steering racks
 - -Backup cameras
 - -Parktronic sensors (blindspot monitoring, ACC, FCW, park sensors) -Air ride suspension
- Inherent Conditions: No arbitration can be based on conditions that are inherent or typical to a particular model or manufacturer. We consider a condition inherent if the manufacturer has issued a TSB related to it.
- If DTC monitors are not set at the time of vehicle registration the post-sale/arbitration liability will fall back to the selling party for seven days.

Rules unrelated to arbitration:

- **ABSOLUTELY NO TEST DRIVES IN THE PARKING LOT!!**
- We have a zero tolerance policy for bringing retail buyers inside the auction. If a retail buyer is brought into the auction the dealer who escorted them will be permanently banned.
